



COVID-19 STATEMENT – SEPTEMBER 2020

Since re-opening in July 2020, we have revised our gaming format and pricing structure to ensure we comply with Government guidelines. With effect from 14 September 2020, we have updated our Covid-19 statement and implemented further measures to adhere to the revised Government restrictions, ensuring the safety of our staff, players and site visitors at all times:-

1. Reduced booking/party sizes for Laser Tag, Splatmaster, Paintballing and Airsoft in line with current Government guidelines, as follows:-
 - Groups of 6 individuals from one or multiple households per gaming zone.
 - Due to the size of our site and layout of the gaming zones, we can run multiple games at any one time without players coming into contact with other groups.
 - Social distancing of 2m with anyone that is not in your household must be adhered to at all times.
 - We will not be taking any walk-on players, all bookings must be made in advance.
2. To enable us to allow for social distancing, we have increased the size of our check-in area and now have two 'safe zones' allowing players to get kitted up safely. These are housed in 75x30ft hangers with tables placed 2m apart, one player allocated per table.
3. We ask all players and parents/guardians to use the hand sanitiser provided upon arrival.
4. We take the temperature of all players and parents/guardians on arrival using a non-contact infrared thermometer to ensure the safety of participants and staff. If a person's temperature registers higher than the Government recommendation of 37.8°C, we will respectfully ask them to leave our site.
5. Our staff have their temperatures taken on arrival each day and wear appropriate PPE at all times.
6. To avoid unnecessary paperwork, we have an online disclaimer that all participants must complete prior to playing (www.iron sightactivities.com/disclaimer). We will retain the details of each player for 21 days after your event as required by the NHS Test and Trace system.
7. If players or anyone that attended with them show any symptoms within 14 days of attending an event at our site, we ask them to contact us so that we can notify NHS Test and Trace.
8. All of our guns, masks and overalls are only used for one party and then removed and cleaned. We already have stringent cleaning processes in place and these will continue as follows:-
 - Masks: washed in a commercial antibacterial solution and hot water and then left to dry for one week. We have over 100 masks available so this ensures every player has an unused, clean mask for their game play.
 - Guns: sprayed with commercial grade antibacterial solution and left to activate for 1-2 minutes to ensure they are thoroughly sterilised before being dried off.
 - Overalls: after every event they are machine washed at 60° and dried before next use.

9. We have increased the size of our car park to allow all visitors to park at a safe distance apart.
10. Due to the size of our site and layout of the gaming zones, parents/guardians can spectate the game play provided they are doing so from a safe distance, wear appropriate safety face/eye protection issued by an Ironsight Marshal and socially distance from each other at 2m.
11. We have implemented one-way systems where appropriate and all players are asked to adhere to the directional arrows and signage at all times.
12. Hand sanitising stations are located throughout the site and we will ensure that everyone uses them at regular intervals throughout their event.
13. All toilet facilities will be operated on a 1 in 1 out basis and will be cleaned between each party booking. Before using the toilet, please use the hand sanitiser provided and again after use. The main door at the entrance to our toilets is always open to reduce the level of hand contact.
14. All surfaces and high touch points will be regularly cleaned throughout the day.
15. If making any purchases on site, please use contactless payment where possible. Our credit card machine is sanitised before and after each transaction.
16. If you require First Aid please find a member of our staff, PPE is available if required.
17. We will close off certain areas and gaming zones if necessary and install screens where appropriate to ensure the safety of our staff and players.
18. We respectfully ask that you do not attend an event if you or anyone in your household has symptoms of Covid-19 or have been instructed to self-isolate (symptoms include high temperature, persistent cough, loss or change to sense of smell or taste).

Gaming/Pricing Structure

All bookings are for 1 hour game play. We can take bookings most days of the week from 9.30am - 4pm, please call or message to check availability. You need to allow 30 minutes to get kitted up, and the Marshals will give you a safety briefing and explain the rules of the games, and then you'll have a full hour of game play.

We have reduced our pricing for the 1 hour game play as we currently cannot offer an eat-in food option as part of the party package. Prices are as follows:-

- **Laser Tag** - £15 per person
- **Splatmaster** - £20 per person
- **Paintball** - £20 per person
- **Airsoft** - £20 per person
